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DIGITAL LEARNING IN DANDORA

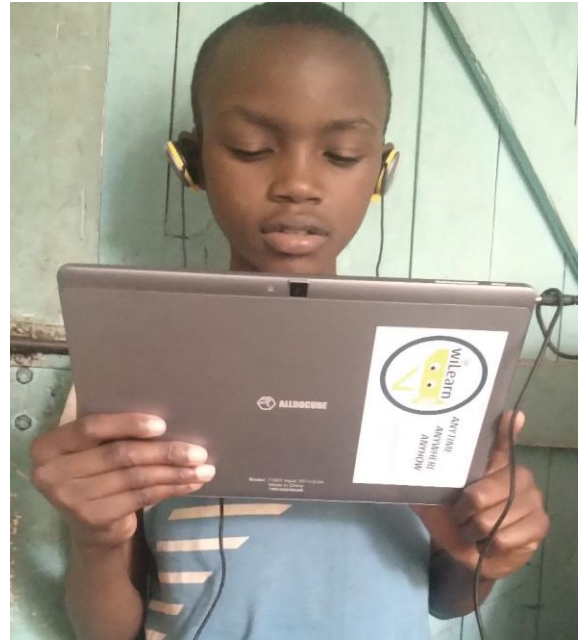

Children hardly access learning materials both in school and at home, a contributory factor to their low performance in classwork and national exams. The chances that a child who have not performed well in academics finding himself or herself fending for livelihood at the dumpsite are so high

Without investment in children academics, it can be so hard to break the poverty cycle in their lives. To improve learning and teaching methodologies, WILEARN 4 LIFE, introduced digital learning at St. Benedict community Centre, Dandora. The digital learning is in conformity with the

Competency Based Curriculum (C.B.C), learner centered curriculum which is in its initial stages of implementation.

On 31st March 2021, we received digital kit from WILEARN 4 LIFE delivered to the centre by Mr. Roland who also carried out familiarization training to our staff.
